At Uniting, our **support coordination** consultants can help you plan and manage your network of supports.

Accommodation supports

At Uniting, we know how important it is to feel comfortable and safe, both at home and when you're living away from home. That's why we have a range of accommodation options for people with disability, which can be funded under eligible NDIS plans.

For children and young people between 7 and 17, we offer **short-term respite accommodation** that offers the chance to sample the world outside home.

Uniting has **shared living** accommodation in the community for people over 18. If you already live out of home, **our improved living arrangements** support assists with tenancy management and other aspects of renting and living alone.

Skills for your best life.

Daily living supports

Through **assistance with daily living** and **life skills development** supports, people with disability can learn new skills to gain independence. There are lots of ways your NDIS plan can enhance your life, from cooking, cleaning and shopping to budgeting, travel training and exploring new interests.

For people who rent, **improved living arrangements** helps you to manage a successful tenancy, while **improved relationships support** is designed for those who'd like to increase their social circles, join groups and engage with the community.

Step out and enjoy the community.

Social and community participation

Whether you choose to take part in a group or one-on-one, **support to participate in the community** provides the opportunity to get out and about and connect with recreational activities. If you want to make new friends and increase your social circles, our **improved relationships** support can help meet your goals.

For those with high support needs, we also offer **specialist disability accommodation** (or SDA). This is available in limited areas. Please contact us to find out more.

Therapy support that comes to you.

Therapy intervention and support programs

Receiving advice and help as early as possible can make a big difference to the lives of children and young people with a disability or developmental delay. Our **specialised individual therapy for early childhood and individual assessment, therapy and/or training** (which includes assistive technology) offers intervention and support services that work within existing family routines, interests and everyday activities, using natural opportunities to learn new things and develop vital life skills.

Services are provided by professionals called key workers, who are also specialists in a core therapy such as speech therapy, physiotherapy or occupational therapy.

Supports for childhood and beyond.

Specialist support for children and young people

Our **daily living supports** work to inspire confidence and independence, ensuring children and young people have the skills they need to participate at school and comfortably enjoy local community activities.

Social and community participation can be delivered after school, on the weekends and during school holidays.

To improve your child's functional capacity, or prevent deterioration, Uniting has therapeutic supports such as early intervention and allied health therapies.

From preschool all the way through to TAFE or work, **life stages transition** supports assist with important milestones. You can also choose **improved relationships** under an NDIS plan to provide behaviour support techniques that enhance connections with family and social networks.

Get connected, stay connected is an innovative, individualised program where we work with schools, parents and students to help children and young people stay engaged in their education. Speak to us about relevant NDIS supports for this program.
